Your primary responsibilities:

- Clean and stage properties for clients and guests: sanitizing, dusting, mopping, vacuuming, making beds, changing linens, laundry, organizing
- Clean commercial spaces, including libraries, office spaces
- Inspect completed cleans for quality control
- Collect and remove trash, drop off at the Cabin Works office
- Replenish consumable supplies like soap and paper products
- Report damage or maintenance issues found during a clean
- Keep owners' closets organized
- Daily tracking of time, job notes, and photos for every visit

Requirements

- Must pass a criminal background check
- Consistent communication with team on work schedule and property status
- Comfortable using a smartphone to take photos, check your schedule, and log job notes
- Follows through on assigned tasks and can be counted on to get them done
- Good physical health and stamina, including the ability to lift and carry up to 40 lbs
- Able to work with little or no supervision while meeting high performance standards
